
## Typical projects

- Grain driers, grain cleaners, colour sorters and other grain processing equipment
- Chain and flight conveyors, belt conveyors, belt and bucket elevators, and screw augers
- Silo dischargers and sweep augers
- Dust extraction equipment, fans, filtration, ductwork and silencing equipment
- Structural steelwork and access platforms, either galvanised or painted finish
- Grain ducting, a complete range of fittings including hand operated, motorised, or electro-pneumatic valves and slides
- Diesel or Kerosene dryer burners, bunded fuel tanks, and gas burner systems
- Electrical control panels and wiring installations utilising the latest technology
- Groundworks, either as part of our package, or in partnership with your preferred civil works contractor
